The Graduate International Relations program at Kateb has been serving as academic and intellectual hub for students from across Afghanistan since the inception of the Kateb with qualified degree holders as faculty members from different parts of the world.

International relations is the study of a country's political principles and processes, its foreign affairs and its relations. International relations includes concentration in subjects such as International Crisis Management, Political Behavior, Major Powers and Central Asia, Economic issues in local and international government systems. Graduates can work as Afghan diplomats or ambassadors, consulate heads and local government officers, or politicians.

CAREER PATHS TO FOLLOW

Graduates of international relations from Afghanistan will have the opportunity to take part in maintaining positive relations between Afghanistan and world, and prevent international conflicts.

There are a number of jobs IR graduates can choose from.

- 1. Diplomat to serve Afghanistan's interests in terms of politics and trade. Some of the major duties of a diplomats are representation, reporting, discussion and negotiation on topics such as war, trade, economy and sometimes social and cultural problems.
- 2. Political Analyst to be hired by the government, media companies or research institutions. Some of the major duties of a political analyst will be to discuss and interpret political crisis, political development and to advise the government official such as the president, ministers and deputy ministers of various topics as well as analyze election results of the media, political parties or the public.

Other jobs you can have as an IR graduate is working as a lobbyist or communication specialists at national or international organizations. These organizations hire IR graduates to deal and convince governments on international level.

Local Government, National and International Business Entities, NGOs, INGOs are some of the employers of a successful IR graduates.

EDUCATION SYSTEM

The educational system at Kateb University is defined based on credit system. In this way, the curriculum designed has a total of 140 credit hours that includes the general courses, main courses, specialization courses, electives and final thesis. For the past few years, the course has been extensively improved in order to reach the great expectations of various core based industries that are involved in managerial business as well as the human resource areas. ABSTRACT

Public Diplomacy, a platform for the development of soft power, it's a new concept in Turkey, which acts as an accelerating factor for the soft power of the foreign policy instrument. Using public diplomacy, especially in the 21th century, not only has been a badge of fear and weakness of the countries, but is a good indicator to assess the sustainability and success level of foreign policy of the countries. The research is focused on the assumption that Turkey's foreign policy is following deep strategic doctrine which trying to promote Turkey's position in the Islamic countries and strengthen the shared cultural affairs. Thus, in order to achieve its goals, Turkey government is more interested in public diplomacy. Like other Islamic countries in Afghanistan, Turkey is also trying to strengthen the bilateral ties and attract Afghans attention through increasing its cultural, educational, and economic and media cooperation. Therefore, presence of a number of Turkey NGOs and associations in Afghanistan and increase of Turkey serials in TVs, increase in Turkey scholarships, expansion of trade relations. Turkey role in Afghanistan peace process and more importantly the tight relation of Dostum with Turkey are the issues that can be studied in terms of Turkey public diplomacy in Afghanistan. However, Turkey's public diplomacy in Afghanistan still faces many challenges; like local nationalism and Islamism. Also in terms of public diplomacy, Turkey has to challenge with powerful rivals such as Iran, China, Saudi Arabia, India, Pakistan and Russia. Mr. Asefi states, "I am happy and proud of learning at Katab University".




ENROLLMEANT
